## Minervoais Frémillant Rosé 2016

*Bright neon pink. Ripe red berries, candied flowers and a suggestion of white pepper on the nose and in the mouth. Juicy and seamless in texture, displaying an appealing blend of heft and energy. Closes supple and subtly sweet, showing good cling and a lingering raspberry note.*

## Minervoais Frémillant Rosé 2014

*Vivid pink. Ripe red berries, cherry pit and floral oils on the emphatically perfumed nose. Juicy and open-knit, with a hint of peppery spices adding lift to the intense raspberry and cherry compote flavors. Quite concentrated but not at all heavy. Finishes smooth, broad and long, leaving suave floral and red fruit liqueur notes behind. This assertive rosé, which would pair wonderfully with strongly seasoned dishes and even red meats, delivers outstanding value.*
