

# Champagne Jacquesson

## Dizy

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*In Champagne, three stars were only given to Bollinger, Egly-Ouriet, **Jacquesson**, Krug, Salon and Seloisse. In the entire region of France, only 56 domaines have obtained this distinction: this includes Domaine de la Romanée Conti and Château d'Yquem as well as Domaine Zind Humbrecht and Château Rayas.*

*I have to say, I was totally blown away by the wines I tasted with proprietor Jean-Hervé Chiquet at Jacquesson this year. I can't think of another estate in Champagne that has so successfully transformed itself in just a handful of years. Most Champagne fans are familiar with the house's 700-series NV wines, which remain absolutely delicious, fairly priced and relatively easy to find. Over the last ten years or so, Jacquesson has also stepped up their program of single-vineyard wines. Quantities are tiny and prices are high, but these are now some of the most compelling wines in the entire region.*

### Cuvée 738

*The 700-Series Champagnes remain some of the best relative values in Champagne, although, sadly, they are hard to find... Jacquesson's transformation into a small, grower estate over the last handful of years is nothing short of remarkable. Readers who haven't tasted these Champagnes in some time own it to themselves to do so. Today, Jacquesson is among Champagne's elite producers, that much is certain.*

### Cuvée 737

*The Brut Cuvée No. 737 is a beautiful wine to drink now and over the next handful of years, while the radiance of the 2009 vintage that informs the blend is on full display. White stone fruits intermingle with floral notes as the wine opens up in the glass, but the 737 is a Champagne of texture above all else. I would drink the 737 now and hold the No. 736, which is based on 2008, for a few years.*
