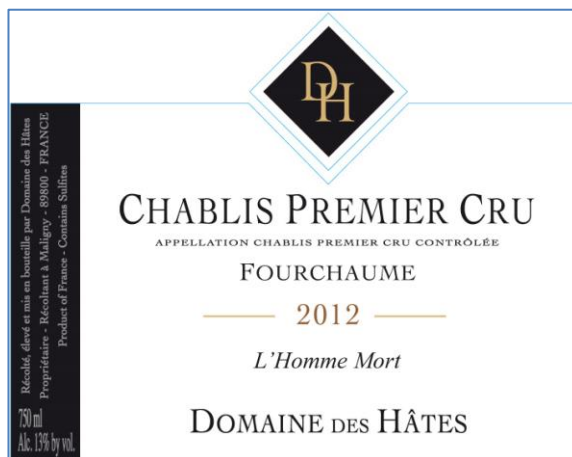


Domaine des Hâtes Chablis



Chablis Fourchaume L'Homme Mort 1er Cru 2012

Crushed stone and menthol aromas show a steely quality, with a floral element providing lift. Supple and fairly rich in the style of the year but with stone and citrus flavors giving shape and definition to the mid-palate. Quite dry and uncompromising on the back end, which shows a touch of youthful harshness today. But the wine's grip suggests that it will reward a few years of cellaring.
