GROWING REGION:

Southwest, Madiran, France.

TERROIR:

From a five-acre parcel of 35-year-old vines. Clay-limestone hillsides facing south to southeast. Farming is certified organic. Hand harvested.

GRAPES:

70% Gros Manseng, 30% Petit Manseng.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Raised on its lees in older barrels for five months. Unfiltered and light fining.

TASTING NOTES:

Shockingly fresh and vibrant with a compelling nose.
