Rully “Clos La Folie” 2017

Aromas of green orchard fruit, warm bread and linden blossom introduce the 2017 Rully Clos la Folie Blanc, a medium to full-bodied, fleshy but lively wine with bright acids, good purity and chalky grip on the finish. It's showing very well.

Rully 1er Cru “Clos du Chaigne” 2017

Scents of smoky peaches and pears mingle with nuances of mint and honeysuckle, introducing the 2017 Rully 1er Cru Clos du Chaigne Blanc, a medium to full-bodied, satiny and gourmand wine with succulent acids and a beautifully pure finish.

Rully 1er Cru Clos St. Jacques 2017

The high point of this year's collection is the 2017 Rully 1er Cru Clos St Jacques Blanc, a medium to full-bodied, bright and precise wine with good cut and concentration that displays aromas and flavors of smoky green orchard fruit and mint. It's well worth seeking out and testifies to Domaine de la Folie's ongoing renaissance.
