CHABLIS 1ER CRU VOSGROS



GROWING REGION:

Chablis, Burgundy, France.

TERROIR:

Limestone and clay soil (Kimmeridgian). From two hill-side parcels totalling 3.5 acres. Vines are 40 years old and are upriver from the town of Chablis in the commune of Chichée on the left bank of the Serein River.

GRAPES:

Chardonnay.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Fermented with native yeast; made and aged in steel.

TASTING NOTES:

This wine has a textured plumpness overlying its racy acidity. Full-bodied and satiny with a core of crisp orchard fruit.
