This is Chateau Monplaisir's zero-sulfur bottling, which they've made since 2015. In 2020, the wine's wild-ferment meatiness adds to a texture amped up by bursting juicy red-berried fruit. That meatiness would push me in the direction of offal, not that I need much of a push: blood sausage, liver and onions, or a kidney pie.

Made as an expression of the pure berry fruits of Malbec, the wine is elegant, structured while ripe with juicy freshness. The wine is very complete, perfumed and will be ready form 2025. Organic.
