

DOMAINE DU PAVILLON DE CHAVANNES

CUVÉE DES AMBASSADES CRU CÔTE DE BROUILLY



GROWING REGION:

Beaujolais, Burgundy, France.

TERROIR:

From the highest and steepest vineyard on the famous Mont Brouilly's meager volcanic soils. The granite and schist here are blue, laced with volcanic porphyry. The domaine farms a total of 12 acres, of which 7 are parcels averaging 40 years of age that are reserved for the Cuvée des Ambassades.

GRAPES:

Gamay.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Fermented in concrete and raised in stainless steel. 20,000 bottles.

TASTING NOTES:

Very old-school Gamay from Beaujolais in the best sense: garnet color, beguiling aromatics, and a burst of refreshment in the mouth that is savory, mineral and toothsome.
