CAHORS TRADITION



GROWING REGION:

Cahors, Southwest, France; the home of Malbec.

TERROIR:

Haut-Monplaisir's vines grow on the prestigious third terrace, or bench, of the Lot Valley, the oldest and highest of the valley's three terraces.

GRAPES:

Malbec.

VITICULTURE NOTES:

Certified organic.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Raised in concrete tanks (70%) and neutral barrels (30%). Aged 20 months. 6,600 cases.

TASTING NOTES:

Dark, rich fruit. Brooding, high-toned wild elegance. In contrast to Argentine Malbec, this is long and mineral rather than fat and fruity. Pairs well with red meats and spicy meals.
