“Granit” Brut Nature NV

All Gamay bubbles with 3 years elevage—so this wine is based on the 2017 vintage. A few extra top notes vs the Tripoz wine. More incisive and insistent attack too; the bubbles less soft but here is a fresher more pure dimension of flavour. Super tasty.

Derived from the 2016 vintage and disgorged in December 2020, the NV Brut Nature Granit reveals notes of pear, almond paste, green apple and white flowers. Medium to full-bodied, bright and sapid, with a pinpoint mousse and a saline finish, this 100% Gamay cuvée is one of the more interesting sparkling wines being produced in southern Burgundy.
