Eola Springs Vineyard “Deux” Pinot Noir, Eola-Amity 2021

A deep jeweled ruby, the 2021 Pinot Noir Deux Eola Springs Vineyard offers up wonderfully pure aromas of raspberry liqueur, crushed flowers, anise and a hint of blue fruit shining through. Medium-bodied, with more refinement and fine tannins, as well as fresh acidity, it has a nice balance of ripeness, tension, and energy. It has great clarity and complexity.

Cherry stones, crushed raspberries, wild strawberries and some cinnamon stick here. Some dusty dried flower petals. It's medium-bodied, pure and clean, with powdery tannins and excellent balance. Mixture of majority whole cluster fermentation with traditional fermentation and carbonic maceration. Drink now.

Willamette Valley “Trois” Chardonnay Johan Vineyard 2021

The 2021 Chardonnay Trois Johan Vineyard is another fantastic effort from the Division Winemaking Company. A shimmering straw appearance brings forward a lovely balance of fresh lift and oak spice, with notes of citrus blossoms, lemon custard, flinty wet stones, and fresh pear. Medium to full-bodied, this continues seamlessly to the palate with a silky and refined texture and a great finish. It is a gorgeous Chardonnay with a Burgundian aesthetic to enjoy over the next 6-8 years.

Willamette Valley “Quatre” Chardonnay, Royer Vineyard, Eola-Amity 2021

A new bottling for them this year, the 2021 Chardonnay Quatre Royer Vineyard takes on a riper and more pronounced personality, with aromas of golden apple, sunbaked hay, and beeswax. Medium-bodied, it also has more density on the palate, with a pithy texture, ripe Meyer lemon driving through the palate, and a savory snap of angular tension on the back.
