

Riesling Berg 2021

Complex nose of fresh and candied lemon with notes of fresh almonds and wet stones. At once generous and vibrant, this youthful dry riesling opens quickly in the glass. Wonderful texture on the concentrated and precise palate, it's at the bottom end of full-bodied, but very cool and refined. Very pure crystalline finish. Matured for more than a year on the lees in stainless steel tank.

The 2021 Riesling Berg is from a south-south-east-facing vineyard on Triassic limestone. Bottled just a month ago, this was primarily made in stainless steel and some clay amphora. The nose is subtle, needing air and temperature to wake up. Tender notions of ripe citrus on the nose remain shy. However, the palate gives a real sense of Meyer lemon and ripe, juicy citrus. This is bone-dry and has a lovely phenolic texture with a hint of pebble and earth on a bone-dry finish. (Bone-dry.)
