Pinot Blanc Paar 2021

Stacks of floral honey and lemon zest aromas give this lively and creamy dry white a lot of appeal. The supple texture and moderate citrusy acidity underline this nicely on the medium-bodied palate. Long finish with more floral honey. As the name suggests this is made from a pair of grape varieities. Normally pinot blanc is the dominant of the two, but this vintage it is a 50/50 cuvee of pinot blanc and auxerrois. From organically grown grapes with Fair'n Green certification. Drink now.
