Deep copper colour. Rather more lift on the nose than the Qualitätswein and much more obviously ripe fruit with an array of wild-flower aromas. Smooth texture and just a little chalkiness on the finish. Bone dry but massive extract. Long. Exciting tension and potential for age but you could drink this now with food.

The bouquet eventually offers up a refined blend of lime, pear, gentle botanicals, a beautifully complex base of slate, dried flowers, lavender and citrus zest. On the palate the wine is bright, full-bodied and beautifully balanced, with a fine core, excellent complexity and grip, zesty acids and a long, poised and very classy finish. This is excellent wine and impressively light on its feet for thirteen percent! 2022-2065.

Nose not yet as expressive as the entry-level trocken 2019 from this estate. But even finer on the palate, with refined fruit and a polished texture. Some pungent notes on the end and a panoply of flavours including most obviously passion-fruit and dill on the finish. This really opens out to a peacock's tail.
